UVA is led by its star backcourt tandem of senior G J.R. Reynolds and junior G Sean Singletary, both of whom average 18.4 points per game, tied for fourth in the conference. Also important to UVA is senior C Jason Cain. He only averages 6.8 ppg, but he brings down 6.6 boards per game and he provides a good interior presence on defense for Virginia.
