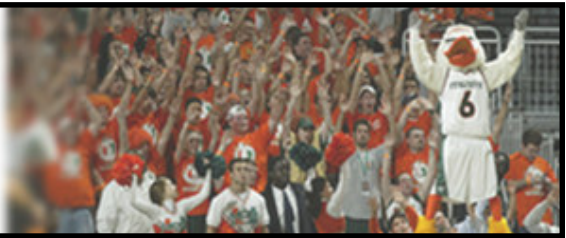

## Canes take 4-0 record up against Bears

The Canes return from Thanksgiving with a team that's undefeated. Beating Marist, VCU, and Providence, the Canes took home the championship trophy from the Puerto Rico tournament last weekend. Coming up huge were C **Anthony King**, G **Jack McClinton**, and G **James Dews**, who led UM in scoring in the championship game.

Unfortunately, the Hurricanes lost F **Adrian Thomas** for the year, as he tore his ACL in practice this week. **Thomas**, who also sat out last year with injuries, has had some rough luck, but he'll be back and better than ever next year. Look for **Dews** and F **Ray Hicks** to get some more playing time at the 3, backing up SF **Brian Asbury**.



Today, as the football team battles Boston College on the road, the basketball team invites the Morgan State Bears into the BUC. Morgan State, founded in 1867, is located in Baltimore, MD, and is considered an historically black college. The school is a public school, though it has only 7,000 students. Morgan State plays in the MEAC, finishing 13-18 last year, with its 10-8 conference record putting it in the middle of the MEAC standings. Its 3-1 start this year is the Bears' best start since 1978.

## Cheering 101

**OFFENSE:**

- "Let's Go Canes!" with claps on each word.
- "Goooo Miami Go!" with 3 claps afterwards.
- "Let's Go UM!" with 5 claps after.

**DEFENSE:**

- "Ohhhhh!" while jumping up and down for the entire possession.

**FREE THROWS:**

- Hold one finger in the air for a Canes FT; if it's made, go "Whoosh! Ohhh!" and then jump and stomp. Stomp twice if he makes both FTs.

**ENEMY PLAYER INTROS:**

- Turn around, with your back to the court, and hold up the "U."
