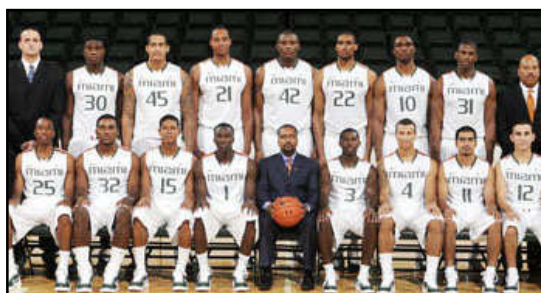

Hurricanes open season against Dolphins

The University of Miami opens up the 2010-11 regular season tonight as the Hurricanes host the Jacksonville University Dolphins. The Canes went 2-0 in their exhibition games, defeating Barry, 102-33, and Florida Southern College, 90-65. Head coach **Frank Haith** had a number of his players shine in the exhibitions, including junior guard **Malcolm Grant** and junior forward **DeQuan Jones**.

Miami returns a pair of players who started 20+ games last season in **Jones** and sophomore guard **Durand Scott**. In addition, two players who averaged 22+ minutes per game are back, in **Grant** and senior forward **Adrian Thomas**. Those four are expected to team with sophomore center **Reggie Johnson** in the starting lineup for the Hurricanes. **Haith** has a deep bench to work with, as the Canes have 11 players who are more than capable of contributing and stepping up on any given night.



The 2010-11 team looks to build upon its strong showing in the ACC Tournament to end last season.

Both Miami and Jacksonville finished last season with a 20-13 record. The Canes went 4-12 in the ACC and finished in last place, while the Dolphins were 14-6 in the Atlantic Sun and tied for first place. Jacksonville returns three starters from last year's team, but the top two scorers, **Ben Smith** and **Lehmon Colbert**, have both graduated.

Ayron Hardy is the leading returning scorer for Coach **Cliff Warren's** Dolphins. The 6'5" senior forward averaged 9.0 points per game last year, as well as 5.6 rebounds. The other starters who are back this season are **Travis Cohn** (8.5ppg) and **Tevin Galvin** (5.6ppg, 4.8rpg). **Cohn** is a senior guard out of Alabama and **Galvin** is a 6-foot-4 junior wing out of Florida.



Russell Powell, a 5'9" sophomore, will be counted upon to step up and run the offense this season after playing just 10.2 minutes per game last season. The Dolphins have a trio of newcomers who are all expected to make an impact this season. **Keith McDougald**, a 6'4" guard from Florida, is one of the top freshmen in the Atlantic Sun. A pair of 6'7" junior forwards, **Shamile Jeffers** and **Delwan Graham**, transferred over from junior college.



- Establish a post game. The Canes have a size advantage inside, yet they've taken too many threes in exhibition play.
- Don't turn the ball over. Turnovers always hurt, but Jacksonville is a team that can capitalize on mistakes.
- Keep playing with energy. The team has looked energized in the two exhibitions.
